WHEREAS, Public Works Week is a national celebration of the tens of thousands of dedicated employees in North America who provide and maintain the infrastructures and services collectively known as “public works”; and

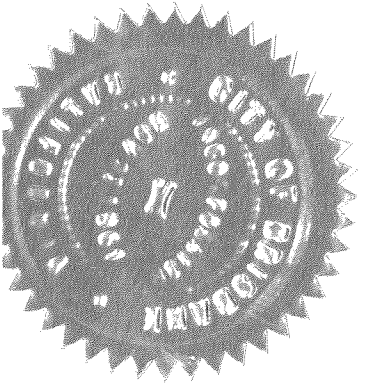
WHEREAS, these critical services are provided daily by professionals who serve the public good with quiet dedication; and

WHEREAS, the Brisbane Public Works Department is responsible for City and Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District storm drain, sewer and water systems, all aspects of public roadway maintenance, traffic signals, public parks, playing fields and landscaped areas, all public buildings, the Sierra Point Landscaping & Lighting District, the City’s Office of Emergency Services, administration of federal floodplain regulations, ensuring compliance with National Pollutant Discharge Elimination system permit requirements, staff support for the Completes Streets Safety Committee and the Open Space and Ecology Committee, and oversight of the Marina; and
