To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to California Labor Code section 1400, et seq. (the “California WARN Act”), this notice is to inform you that Sangamo Therapeutics, Inc. (the “Company”) plans to initiate an action that may be deemed a “mass layoff” under the California WARN Act.

The Company plans to permanently terminate the employment of 30 employees assigned to its location at 7000 Marina Blvd, Brisbane, CA 94005 on June 26, 2023.
