A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BRISBANE RECOGNIZING STUART SCHILLINGER
FOR HIS DECADES OF SERVICE TO THE CITY OF BRISBANE

WHEREAS, Stuart Schillinger played a key leadership role in the fiscal management of the City of Brisbane for over 21 years; and

WHEREAS, Stuart provided insight and creative solutions to the many public policy issues that arose during his tenure, first as Finance Director in 2001, then additionally as Administrative Services Director, and now as Assistant City Manager; and

WHEREAS, Stuart explored program-based budgeting, which evolved into priority-based budgeting. This innovative approach gave Brisbane leaders the framework to make financial decisions based on an organization's goals tied to five values: Safety, Community Building, Ecological Sustainability, Fiscally Prudent, and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, Stuart promoted significant changes in technology, budgeting, and utility management. He also led the City's Innovation Group, Equity Plus Inclusion Committee (EPIC), and in 2021, helped launch the Council-appointed Inclusion, Diversity, Equity & Accountability (IDEA) Committee; and

WHEREAS, Stuart was instrumental in leading staff development of the funding package for the New Brisbane Library. The effort was successful turning the project into a reality, with the completed Library opening last April; and

WHEREAS, Stuart exercised strong management skills in his leadership of Finance, Parks and Recreation, Human Resources, IT, and Open Space during his tenure. Stuart led by example, and was generous in sharing knowledge. He provided strong support to staff, as well as coaching young professionals through the City's Intern program.

WHEREAS, Stuart's leadership, mentorship, and guidance in the organization will be sorely missed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that we issue this proclamation to recognize the positive impact of Stuart's contributions over the past twenty-one years, and in appreciation for his efforts, that will continue to benefit the community at-large and the next generation.
