WHEREAS, according to the Federal Asian Pacific American Council (FAPAC), the theme for AAPI Heritage Month 2023 is "Advancing Leaders Through Opportunity" encouraging the advancement of leaders in local and national governments by prioritizing collaboration, development, diversity, transparency, and inclusion through leadership training of Asian American Pacific Islanders; and

WHEREAS, as we celebrate Asian American and Pacific Islander communities, we must also redouble our commitment to combating the surge of anti-Asian hate crimes and commemorate the victims who have been lost to anti-Asian violence during the pandemic and throughout history; and
