Parks and Recreation Commission (4 seats for terms until 2026) Meets on the second Wednesday of each month at 6:30pm

Planning Commission (2 seats for terms until 2026)

The Planning Commission meets regularly on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month at 7:30pm

Complete Streets Safety Committee (3 or 5 seats for terms until 2026)

The term of service is for four years. The Complete Streets Safety Committee usually meets regularly on the first Monday of each month at 6:30pm.

Open Space and Ecology Committee (5 seats for terms until 2026)

Meets regularly on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 6:30pm

Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Accountability (IDEA) Committee (7-11 seats for terms until 2024 & 2026)*

Inclusion, Diversity, Equity & Accountability (IDEA) Committee

On September 23, 2021, the City of Brisbane City Council approved the creation of a new City Committee - the Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Accountability (IDEA) Committee.

Purpose

IDEA Committee members would define what Diversity and Inclusion means for the City. Members would also be an ambassador for the City to various aspects of the community, and the Committee would provide insight and feedback to the City Council on issues related to diversity and inclusion.

Membership

The Membership of the Committee would be between 7-11 members. Members would be selected by Council appointment. People who are eligible to apply are Brisbane residents and people who worked in Brisbane. The subcommittee thought it was important that people who work in town could be represented on this committee which could broaden the perspectives on this new committee.

Meeting Dates & Times

IDEA will meet monthly, and committee members will determine the day and time of their meetings to allow for people who are not normally able to serve on committees due to time constraints to find a better day and time than if the date was preset.
