DEPARTMENT STRUCTURE & STAFFING

- 7 full-time employees
- Approximately 40 part-time staff working in various program areas including aquatics, facilities, childcare, and seniors.
- P&R department staff work in parallel with the P&R Commission to provide high-quality programs, facilities, and events for the Brisbane community.
- The Commissions 5-7 members are appointed by the City Council for terms of four years each and meets on the second Wednesday of each month at 6:30pm.





COMMISSIONER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Act in an advisory capacity to the City Council on policy matters pertaining to the acquisition and development of parks and the formulation of recreation programs to meet the needs of the citizens.
- Periodically review and make recommendations on the parks and recreation element of the City's General Plan.
- Actively promote parks and recreation activities within the City.

Commissioners participate as key stakeholders in the development of City policies, ordinances, and master plans. In the past, P&R Commissioners played an integral role and served in an advisory capacity on the following:

- Crocker Trail Master Planning
- Facility naming policy

- Volleyball Court installation and private partnership
- Development of the public art implementation guidelines and public art ordinance
- Youth Advisory Committee liaisons
- Childcare modular replacement
- New community events
