Smoke Alarms Carbon Monoxide Detectors Residential Construction

When a home is remodeled or improved upon with a valuation of \$1000 or more, the State of California Residential Code requires that smoke alarms and Carbon Monoxide detectors be installed.

The Building inspector will come inside the residence to verify the installation. However, The City of Brisbane understands that sometimes there is limited access to the interior of the property; therefore the Property Owner or Contractor can verify the installation by signing the form below.

Smoke Alarms shall be installed:

- 1. In each sleeping room
- 2. In the hallway leading to the sleeping rooms
- 3. 1 on each level or story of the home

<u>Carbon Monoxide detectors</u> shall be installed in all dwellings containing a fuel burning appliance in these locations:

- 1. Outside each sleeping room
- 2. On each level
- 3. If a fuel burning appliance is attached to a bedroom, then one in the bedroom.

I further attest that all smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms are installed and working at the required locations.
