which was approved by the Planning Commission on June 27, 2019, for the Biotechnology Research and Development Campus, with modifications to include Signs at the Parking Garage/Retail Building at 800 Sierra Point Parkway, modification to the wall signs at 1400 and 1600 Sierra Point Parkway to accommodate a previously approved building addition that connects the two buildings, and text

modifications to the previously approved monument signs.
