ENVIRONMENTAL

the State CEQA Guidelines--this proposal falls within a class of projects which the State has determined not to have a significant effect on the environment. The exceptions contained in Section 15300.2 of

the Guidelines do not apply.

Written information or comments that may include a person's name, address, email address, etc., submitted to the City, City Council, Council Commissions and Committees and City staff are public records under the California Public Records Act, are subject to disclosure and may appear on the City's website. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
