NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on <u>Thursday, May 14, 2020</u>, at 7:30 p.m., virtually via videoconference broadcast on local Comcast channel 27 and the City's YouTube channel, to consider the following matter:

APPLICATION NO .:	Zoning Text Amendment RZ-1-20
APPLICANT:	City of Brisbane
LOCATION:	Citywide
ZONING:	R-1, R-2, R-3, R-BA, NCRO-2, SCRO-1, PAOZ-1, PAOZ-2, and PD Zoning Districts
REQUEST:	The Planning Commission will consider and make recommendations to the City Council regarding proposed zoning amendments to update the City's existing Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) regulations to comply with new state legislation passed in 2019 regulating ADUs and junior ADUs (JADUs).
	The proposed zoning amendments will also increase the Floor Area Ratio exemption for covered parking on 3,700 sq ft or smaller lots to 400 sq ft (equivalent to two parking spaces) in the R-1, R-2, and R-3 Residential Zoning Districts.
ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS:	The project is exempt from the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080.17, which states that the CEQA does not apply to the adoption of local ordinances regulating construction of second units, and by CEQA Section 15282(h) that exempts adoption of an ordinance regarding second units in single-family and multifamily residential zones. In addition to being statutorily exempt from CEQA, the project is consistent with the General Plan per State CEQA Guidelines Section 15183(a)this proposal falls within a class of projects which are consistent with existing zoning or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall therefore not require further review. The exception to this section requiring environmental review as might be necessary to examine project specific significant effects does not apply.

HOW TO VIEW THE MEETING

This meeting will be conducted exclusively via videoconferencing in compliance with the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 and the San Mateo County Health Officer's amended Shelter in Place Order effective

March 31, 2020. The purpose of this virtual public meeting is to provide the safest environment for staff, Planning Commissioners, and the public while ensuring public participation. The Community Meeting Room at City Hall will remain closed and inaccessible to the public until large public gatherings are permitted to resume.
