Idling over and about to marina happenings...

- ◆ On approach or departure from the marina, please take note of tides. Minus tides occur regularly and can reduce the entrance/channel depth to below 7' of water. Page 2 shows proper channel and harbor entrance approach to maintain depth.
- ◆ If/when you're selling your boat that is within the marina, please remember:
 - ◆ Seller needs to submit a written 30 day Notice to the marina office
 - ◆ Seller, do **not** hand over gate fobs to the buyer; all fobs must be returned to the office. The buyer needs to visit the marina office and inquire about the proper application process, and provide information to start the process
 - ◆ The slip does not necessarily go with the sale of the vessel; transfer of the slip depends on the waitlist and other possible circumstances
- ◆ Are you planning to have work performed on your vessel by a vendor? Please contact our office to authorize access to your vessel ahead of time.
- ◆ Friendly reminder: we do not accept mail for boaters in our office. If you need mail service, please visit the local post office within Brisbane for a PO Box.

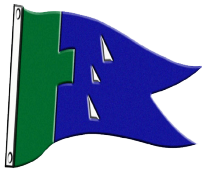
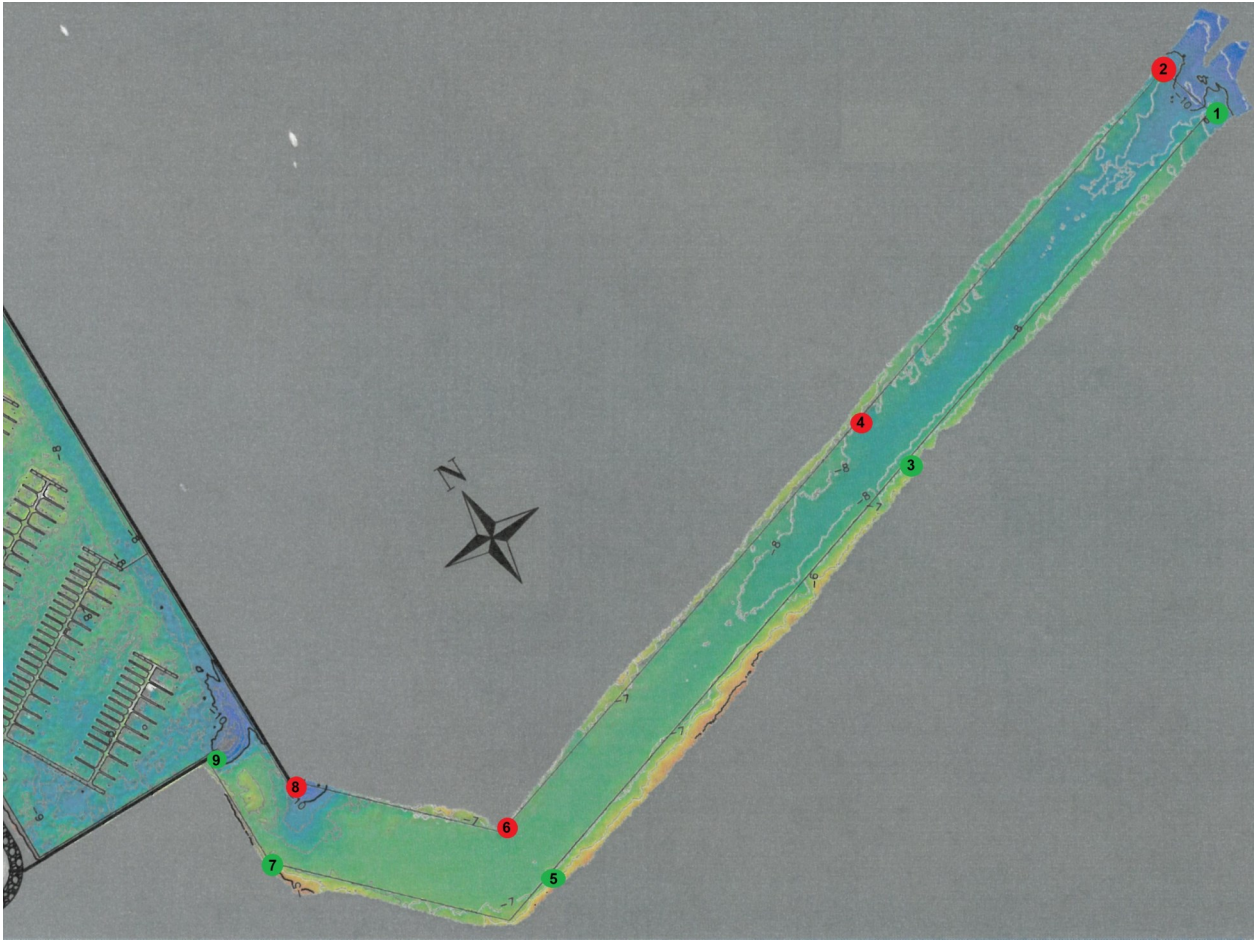

An Update from SPYC:
