Watch For April Fools...

Spring has sprung, longer evenings are here and hopefully nice weather is around the corner. It surely sparks the interest of ensuring the boat is ready to head out on the open water, especially if you didn't have an opportunity to take advantage of the nice weather back in January and February. So if you didn't, no worries because there's no better time than the present to get her ready! Before getting underway, here are a few quick reminders to help towards an enjoyable and uneventful outing:

- * Has the impeller been replaced within the last season, or two at most? If not, take a moment to replace it; it could mean the difference of coming back under your own power, or under tow.
- * Are your fire extinguishers and flares up to date?
- * Do you have enough life jackets for everyone onboard, and are they easily accessible? Type IV throwable?
- * Do the bilge pump(s) operate properly?

Admittingly, the above may sound obvious or redundant, however in the instance of a situation, these items can commonly be some of the easiest to have overlooked before leaving the dock. For an additional set of eyes to help prepare, you may also contact the local USCG Aux to schedule a vessel safety inspection, which are free of cost. Swaying towards additional marina items:

- * Reminder: Parking Permits are required in any parking lot designated by signage requiring a "Marina Permit". Any vehicles not properly displaying a permit issued by the Marina office, may be subject to a ticket and/or towing at the vehicle owner's expense.
- Our garbage cans and dumpsters are not junk collection sites for unwanted furniture, car or boat parts, electronics or other debris that needs to be taken to the dump. Please help us keep our marina looking its best by disposing of such items appropriately, and taking them to the correct facilities. If the item(s) you're getting rid of may have value to another boater, please review our Swap Meet section of our monthly newsletter for how to post the item(s) for sale.
- * All vendors coming to the marina to work on your boat are required to check in at the Marina Office, before and at the end of their work, regardless if they have a fob for entrance or not—no exceptions. Additionally, do not provide a vendor with one of your fobs; the vendor needs to check in and check out a fob from the Marina Office.
- * Reminder—there is <u>NO</u> fueling of boats in the marina. Spills, even if accidental, cause an environmental issue that is expensive and time consuming to control and clean up. Refuel your boat at a proper fuel dock, where they are monitoring and prepared for dealing with a potential discharge at a moments notice. Help us keep our waters clean and enjoyable for everyone.
