- Update to last month: An amendment was made to the Slip License Agreement regarding dock steps (section 11.c), and was emailed out on July 21, and posted on the gates of each dock. Please take a moment to review the amendment. If you are needing to replace your current homemade step with a commercially made one, and have a question of whether the new one you are looking at will comply, you may email us with the specs for review to: <u>harbormaster@brisbaneca.org</u>
- Parking lots: Your vehicles may be parked here during the time you are coming out to use your boat. Vehicles are not to be stored here. Vehicles are subject at all times to current DMV regulations required to be on the road, and may be enforced by Brisbane PD.
- Friendly reminder: There is to be no storage of any items, such as dinghies, BBQ's, boxes, bicycles, jerry jugs, etc. on the dock or dock fingers. Please help us keep our docks clean and safe for all to enjoy.
