Plowing over to marina items:

- * GREAT NEWS! San Mateo County's Household Hazardous Waste facility is apparently taking in expired flares. To dispose of your old flares aboard your vessel, you will need to contact them to set an appointment to drop them off. To make an appointment, visit their website at: <https://www.smchealth.org/hhw> or call: (650) 372-6200.
- * Garbage - If you wouldn't throw it in your kitchen garbage can at home, do not throw it in ours here at the marina. Please help us by disposing of your car parts, boat parts, home furniture, carpet, electronics, beds, etc. at the proper facilities throughout the Bay Area. Your help and cooperation in keeping our marina and grounds clean, is much appreciated.
- * Reminder: do not hold doors or gates open for people or vendors who you do not know. Either of the above will have a gate fob to access the dock or restrooms if they are genuinely allowed to be in our facilities. We are simply wanting to make sure you and your vessel stay safe and secure.
- * The winds have been howling, and at no shortage of speeds near gale force. With sustained wind events, it does have a tendency to take a toll on your dock lines, canvas coverings, and other items stowed on deck. Please take a moment to check on your vessel, and readjust the lines as needed for keeping the boat properly within the slip; we want to make sure your boat does not overhang the dock and cause an issue for other people walking down the dock.

Lastly, a Thank You to one of our boaters who generously donated a patio furniture set to our laundry room area. This will surely make it a more comfortable experience when doing your laundry chores.

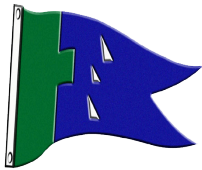
