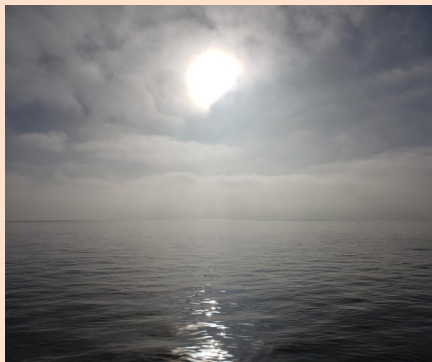

Reminder: Blood Donation Event at SPYC on Feb 23rd

February is a unique month. Why, you ask? Well, here are a couple fun facts: it is the shortest month of all other months in the calendar year at only 28 days. It encompasses Valentine's Day (started back in ~ 500 A.D.), and marks the end of Winter, hinting of warmer days ahead. It is also the only month that changes the number of days it has; every four years it goes from 28 to 29 days representing a Leap Year. By the way, the next Leap Year is in 2024. February truly is an interesting month!

Aside from the trivia, we can all probably agree that COVID/Omicron has made itself known, AGAIN, and perhaps you have had first hand experience with the virus at this point. Just when we all thought COVID was starting to recede...UGH! That said, we have reduced the number of hours that our marina front office door is open to public access, to reduce ours and your potential exposure. Walk-ins are being allowed on Tuesday and Thursday, from 9am to 1pm. All people entering the building must be symptom free, and wearing a mask. If you cannot make it in during those hours, or simply do not wish to visit in person, we are still accessible by phone and email during regular business hours at: (650) 583-6975, or harbormaster@brisbaneca.org. Switching gears and heading to some reminders and marina items:

- * For your safety, and to not cause potential damage elsewhere, DO NOT attempt to shut off ANY utilities here at the marina on your own. Contact the marina office (650) 583-6975, or the non-emergency line of Brisbane PD (415) 467-1212 for after hours, if there are any issues with a broken water pipe or other service on the dock(s).
- * Our dumpsters are for normal household garbage; they are not for electronics, engine parts, furniture, or other bulky items that should be taken to a transfer or authorized dump station. If you need information or locations on where to take certain items, please contact our office. We have flyers here for you to take with you on household items and proper disposal methods.
- * Reminder: monthly slip payments are due before the month's end, for the next month's slip fees. Paying on the 1st or later is constituted as being late, and will incur a late fee being added to the statement. If you would like to avoid having to think about the payment each month, please contact our office for discussing the option to be put on auto-payment with a Visa, MC or Discover credit card.
- * When walking the docks, I'm still seeing quite a few past due registration stickers on boats. Please make sure to get the updated registration posted aboard, and provide our office with a current copy of your CA DMV registration, or USCG documentation.

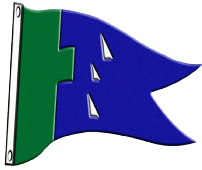
