Roses Are Red, Violets Are Blue...


...what did you get for your boat, and is your boat thinking of you, too?!

There for a moment, I wasn't sure if we would need a kayak to get from point A to point B, whether that was on the road or trying to walk to the docks! Relentless pouring rain, king tides and the State letting out water from the reservoirs made for a perfect storm, which I can pleasantly say, the marina faired very well with only a few minor issues.

Of course, along with high waters and seemingly endless rains, it ended up washing loads of debris into the waterways in and about the bay and delta regions. Naturally, it has worked its way into the marina, inundating us with flotsam with each ebb and flood of the tide. While we appreciate your help, please do not pull out the small debris and lay it on the dock; this relieves one issue while creating another. We ask if it becomes necessary to remove small twigs or sticks from the water around your boat, please help us by making the trip up to one of the large dumpster enclosures to dispose of it properly. However, if you spot a larger log or other navigational hazard, please call it into our office and we will work to get it secured out of the way until it can be removed safely at a later date. We greatly appreciate your help in keeping our marina clean!

Crossing over to some safety tips and other reminders:

- * **Notification:** The South restrooms will not have hot water until further notice. We are in the process of removing and replacing a leaking water heater, and we will remove the notices on the doors when the hot water has been restored. We appreciate your understanding while we get this replaced as quickly as we can.
- Safety tip #1: An issue I've seen over the years, but thankfully not frequent, has dealt with a plugged or malfunctioning vented loop on a head intake line. The vented loop is designed to prevent a syphon from starting and overfilling the head aboard, when the head/toilet is below waterline, which could lead to a much larger issue such as sinking the vessel. Please check your vented loop regularly, and service/replace if needed. As a additional safety measure, it's good to get in the habit of closing any thru-hulls located below waterline when the boat is not in use.



- * Safety tip #2: Before you remove your power cord from the electrical outlet on the dock box, please make sure to shut off the breaker associated with your cord. This will help prevent arcing from a load still potentially drawing from your vessel and causing failure at the receptacle and your cord end.
- * **Reminder:** If or when the time comes to sell your boat, please stop in or call the Harbor Office to discuss the proper notification, potential for transferring the slip, and access to the dock for the buyer.
- * **Reminder:** Parking lots are for your vehicle when you are on or using your boat. At no point should any vehicle be stored in the parking lot without express permission granted by the Harbormaster. Vehicles that are non-functioning,

wrecked, or have expired tags are subject to citation and towing at the vehicle owner's expense.






