It's leap year with 366 days, or 366 opportunities to get your boat out on the water. No excuses, let's do this! (enter sounds of loud thunder, hail and rain) AND of course as I type this out, the skies have opened up and torrential rain with hail has started. So, I guess if you don't want to navigate through isolated thunder and showers on the water, I don't blame you—I wouldn't want to head out at the moment either. But, like most things, this too shall pass. Until then, I hope you all are able to stay dry!

Along the topic of safety, and in an effort to be proactive versus reactive, most theft is based on opportunity. If we eliminate the opportunity, or severely hinder the ability to easily take someone's belongings, it helps deter theft from happening in the first place. I'll admit, I'm as guilty as the next person in becoming complacent, knowing I should lock something or put something away, so please take a moment to be proactive and ensure your cabin doors are locked when you're not aboard, dinghies are secured or stowed below deck, and outboards are not hanging out in the breeze on the stern rail asking to be slipped off the holder. Additionally, if you see something that doesn't look right, or doesn't appear to belong within the marina (dinghies running around the marina in the dark with no lights on, darkly painted, or suspicious activity in general), please report it to our marina office during hours of 8am to 5pm Monday through Saturday, or if sighted after hours, call Brisbane PD at (415) 467-1212. If we all keep our eyes open, we can continue to help keeping our marina safe and secure.

A few reminders:

- * Laundry is one of those necessary evils most of us loathe doing, and with limited laundry facilities available onsite, please be courteous by removing your clothes from the washer or dryer on time. Other boaters may be waiting for the opportunity to use the laundry machines, too.
- * Check your bilges! With the past couple rainstorms, and more in the upcoming forecast, please check your bilges for operational bilge pumps and any potential contaminants that cannot be pumped overboard. If you find fuel or oil in your bilge, shut off your bilge pump immediately and report the discovery to our marina office. We want our waters within the marina and bay to stay as clean as possible.
- * Dock carts—please return them to the head of the dock as soon as you're done loading/unloading your items. There are a limited number of dock carts for use by all.

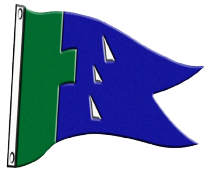
