Happy New Year!

Farewell 2023 and hello 2024! We hope all of you have enjoyed a wonderful holiday season. With a fresh start to a new year, it typically leads people into a review of their past year of activities and brings about a plan and goals for the new year. What resolutions have you put in place? Personally, I'm looking to get off the dock and get out sailing more. There are so many places I would love to see, and from the water, it provides a different perspective and experience than driving or flying.

A little preemptive to my New Year resolution being set, I was afforded an opportunity to jump aboard a sailboat once again and head out on another trip down the California coast. I flew out of SFO and met up with the Captain where I boarded the vessel, and a couple days later, we would sail south. However, before we could head out, we had to provision and patiently wait for weather to cooperate. Soon enough, we pulled out of Morro Bay on an ebb tide around 11am the morning of departure. The wave state was a bit lumpy and the wind dead off the bow. It turned out to be a bit more of a motor-sailing trip than anticipated with the wind coming out of the south, but we happily rounded Pt. Conception with little wave or wind (picture in the header is a sunset near Conception), making it a smooth transition from Northern California to Southern. However, the Santa Ana winds piped up early the following a.m. just off the Channel Islands, which provided a rough ride for multiple hours until we were able to get far enough south to be past the gale. With the extended motoring, we were forced to pull into Channel Island Harbor after the winds died down for refueling, catching a warm meal ashore and some much needed sleep. The following day, we departed again and were able to finally sail for a while, making it down to Redondo Beach, where unfortunately, my time came to an end and had to fly back to SFO. I'm keeping my fingers crossed to hop aboard again, but perhaps next time, in clear waters and warmer temps!

On another note, let's start the year off right with some reminders:

- * If the office is closed for holiday or normal scheduled day of closure, and a non-life threatening emergency arises, you are to call Brisbane PD non-emergency line to report the issue at: (415) 467-1212. DO NOT attempt to shut down water or power on your own. An appropriate person will arrive to address the issue.
- * Throughout the year, many people's phone numbers, emails, mailing addresses can change. If any of the above apply to you, please make sure we have your current and correct contact information. This greatly aides us with getting in contact with you within a timely manner in case of an emergency.
- * Wind and rain, go away, have you checked your dock lines and bilge pump today?! I can't stress this enough. Scraped hulls, soggy carpets and floating floorboards are not fun items to deal with.
- * It's 2024, which means previous CA registration stickers for all 2023 vessels are due. Submit your updated registration and USCG documents to our office and apply those DMV '25 stickers appropriately on the hull.



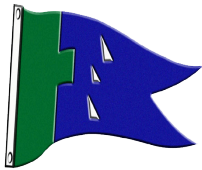
