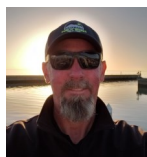


Coming about and steaming towards marina items:

- * Hazardous chemicals, waste and/or other related items are not to be stored on the dock, within the dock boxes, or left by the garbage can enclosures. If you have used engine oil, oil filters, oil pads, oil containers, zincs or other items related to your vessel, we may be able to recycle them here at the office, properly. Please check with our office whether we take items not mentioned above, or you can also reach out to San Mateo County's Household Hazardous Waste facility to dispose of items. - * Do not abandon your vessel. Knowing the cost and process of properly disposing of a vessel can be daunting, but you have options that don't get you in trouble. If that time has come where your vessel is no longer wanted or isn't seaworthy, we might be able to help. Brisbane Marina has a State funded Grant to deal with disposing of vessels that are State registered, and at no cost to the registered owner. - * Dock Steps: dock steps are to be commercially made and not of the homemade variety. Another inspection will be made through the harbor here soon. For questions regarding proper steps that are allowed, please refer to the amendment of the Slip License Agreement, section 11-c, dated July 2021, or stop by our office to request a copy if needed. If you are debating whether a step would be acceptable, you may also send information to our email for review before acquiring the new step at: harbormaster@brisbaneca.org.
- * Vendors working on your boat: All vendors are required to check in and out of our marina office upon arrival and departure. Each vendor must also provide, or have previously provided, insurance for working within the marina, showing Brisbane Marina as the additional insured/document holder. Also, if you are prearranging a vendor to work on your boat when you're not here, please give us a heads up of their arrival.

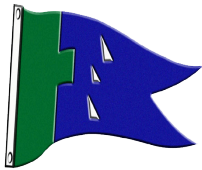
