<u>2023 Tide Tables</u> Available in Marina Office 6 months down, fiscal is over and we continue heading into the windy time of year, staggering (sometimes literally walking with a crosswind on the dock) through the "summer" months. It doesn't seem quite possible that half of 2023 has already passed, but as the ol' adage goes, "time flies when you're having fun!" But don't fret, the nice weather and great boating are still yet to come. Although, if you're participating in the Tuesday night sail races with SPYC, the wind is a welcome commodity to navigate the race course in a timely fashion ~ STARBOARD!

As many know the wind is a constant factor, and trying to plan activities either outside or on the water can be daunting at times. I was recently told about an app you can download on your phone or tablet that will show the direction of the wind, how fast it is currently blowing, or look ahead at forecasts, too. Whether you have

an Android or Apple device, look for the Windy.app. Some other additional features I didn't realize it had, until I downloaded it myself, include tide tables, current and wave frequency, weather and more. Definitely a handy app in your tool bag of navigation equipment when you're deciding whether to head out, if you should reef the sails, or con-



sider ducking into a protected cove for an upcoming wind event. Check it out and see what you think. And if you have any other suggestions on cool or helpful apps that could help other boaters have a good time on the water, email your suggestions to harbormaster@ci.brisbane.ca.us for being included in an upcoming newsletter.

Rounding about to a few marina items:

- In the continued efforts to keep our Marina running smoothly, please note the following with regards to all vendors, which includes surveyors and yacht brokers. Anyone performing work within the Marina is required to have their insurance and Brisbane business license (BBL) on file with our office in order to gain access to our docks. Any yacht brokers listing your vessel within our Marina, as well as all surveyors, are required to have the BBL as well. Please check with our office ahead of any business person arriving to verify they are allowed on the docks to get down to your vessel.
- If you are thinking it's time to cut the ties to your vessel due to condition or not being repairable, you may want to consider surrendering your vessel through our SAVE/VTIP grant. This is no cost to you, and the vessel will be disposed of in a safe and legal manner. For more information on our SAVE grant, please stop by our office or email me for further details. Time is limited under our current grant, so if this is of interest, please email or contact me before August 15, 2023 to discuss eligibility.
- You won't want to miss this: San Mateo County is hosting an event at **Coyote Point** on **July 15th** to give away free reusable electronic distress signaling devices. This is not a flare collection event; please see the flyer on page 4 for more details.
