Changing lines to marina tidbits:

- ♦ Please help us in keeping our marina and bay waters clean by making sure you separate your garbage from the recyclables, and putting them in the proper containers at the head of each dock. **Do not** leave any garbage, bags, cardboard, or other items outside the receptacles; it will blow into the marina & bay waters.
- Cardboard is bulky and does not belong in the garbage or recyclable containers at the docks. There is cardboard recycling dumpsters at the head of Dock 1 and in the mid-level parking lot of dock 4; please take a moment to break down the boxes/cardboard before disposing in either of the two above mentioned locations.
- Reminder: Painting of the dock handrails, gates and gate houses is coming to a close. Please utilize the provided bicycle racks along the promenade of the marina, and do not lock anything to the handrails or light poles.
- ♦ Illegal dumping of boat items, household belongings, oil, appliances, etc. is strictly prohibited. Please ask our office, or maintenance crew, for appropriate methods, or facilities, to properly dispose of your unwanted items. By doing so, you're helping us keep our marina and facilities clean and looking its best for yours and everyone's enjoyment.
