Touching on the marina, here's a quick update regarding the front office admin position: we are currently mid-stream in the process of finding a qualified candidate, and hopeful we will find that suitable replacement here in the very near future. In the interim, we are still working to maintain a smooth state of operations, and will respond as quick as we can to any questions or concerns that may arise. Casting off the lines and drifting over to marina items:

- * Reminder: slip payments are due before the end of each month, for the succeeding months rent. If you are on auto pay, and you have had any changes in your billing address, card info, or expiration date, please keep us apprised before your card is ran. If you would like to be added to auto-pay, please contact the office to get your account set up.
- * Dock lines, halyards, and other stretchable items have been put to the test in a consistent fashion over the last month or two with rather impressive wind events. Please take a moment to stop and check on your boat's dock lines for any broken strands or fraying, and any other running rigging that could be “slapping or clanging” in the wind.
- * Dock fingers are not for storage. Please remove any and all personal items, dinghies, chairs or other belongings from the dock fingers. These items create tripping hazards for our maintenance staff and adjacent clients as well. Additionally, there is to be no storage of any type of fuel containers on the dock or in the dock boxes. These pose a huge risk for leaking and causing contamination to our waters.
- * Reminder: when the time arises for selling your boat, DO NOT hand over your gate fob to the buyer. For security and liability purposes, please arrange for bringing them to our office so we may collect the necessary information before granting access to our docks. Your help is greatly appreciated in keeping our facilities safe and secure for everyone.



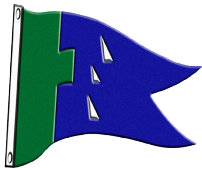
