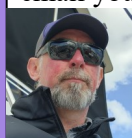

You just might get cloudy, misting with a chance of rain, some wind to possible small craft warnings or being calm with sun (for a hot second) with cool temps settling back in the evening. Mother Nature, can we have a word?! I guess that's why there's the saying, "The coldest winter I ever spent was a summer in San Francisco." Drifting over to marina related items and reminders:

- ◆ **Selling your boat:** If you are selling your boat with a broker, or on your own, please notify the office that you are intending to sell the boat. If selling the boat on your own, you must accompany the potential buyer down the dock and show them the boat. We will not let people on the docks without proper representation. If using a broker, the broker must have their Brisbane Business License and proper insurance on file within our office to be on our docks as well. For more information on this scenario, please stop in the office to discuss further if you're thinking of selling.
- ◆ **Harbor Speed:** There is to be NO WAKE in the marina. You as the boat captain/owner is responsible for any damage caused by the wake of your boat to other vessels and/or our docks. Please also keep in mind that if you are steaming into the harbor, the roller of a wake behind the boat doesn't stop because you slow down. Please be at NO WAKE speed by the time you get to our sea-wall.
- ◆ **Illicit discharge:** Check your bilges often. If there is any fuel, oil, waste or anything other than water, shut off your bilge pump, clean out the bilge and dispose of the liquid/waste properly. This waste does not go in our garbage cans or dumpsters. - ◆ **Lien boats:** For any vessels that will be coming up for lien, please check our bulletin board in front of the Harbormaster's office for postings.

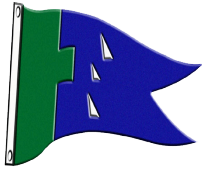
