Shifting directions over to marina items:

- * To dispel a common myth, having two boats in the marina **does not** constitute the ability to live aboard one or both of the boats. You must first be eligible to apply for a live aboard, then submit your application, and then go through the inspection and review process for further consideration. If you are interested in living aboard, or would like to discuss further, please contact our office for more information.
- * For everyone's safety and the security of our marina, **DO NOT** lend out your key fobs. The slip licensee, or authorized co-applicants, are the only people who should have the key fob(s). Lending them out to friends and/or family, is a security issue and violation of the slip license agreement. Please help us in keeping you, your vessel safe, and our marina safe and enjoyable!
- * Reminder: dock power cords are meant to be routed along a dry path. Please route your cord along the deck of your boat and make sure it does not drop through the water.
- * Storage of SUPS, dinghies, rowing boats, canoes or other axillary craft must be stowed aboard your vessel, or within the slip so that it does not affect the adjacent slip client. There is to be no storage on the docks at anytime.

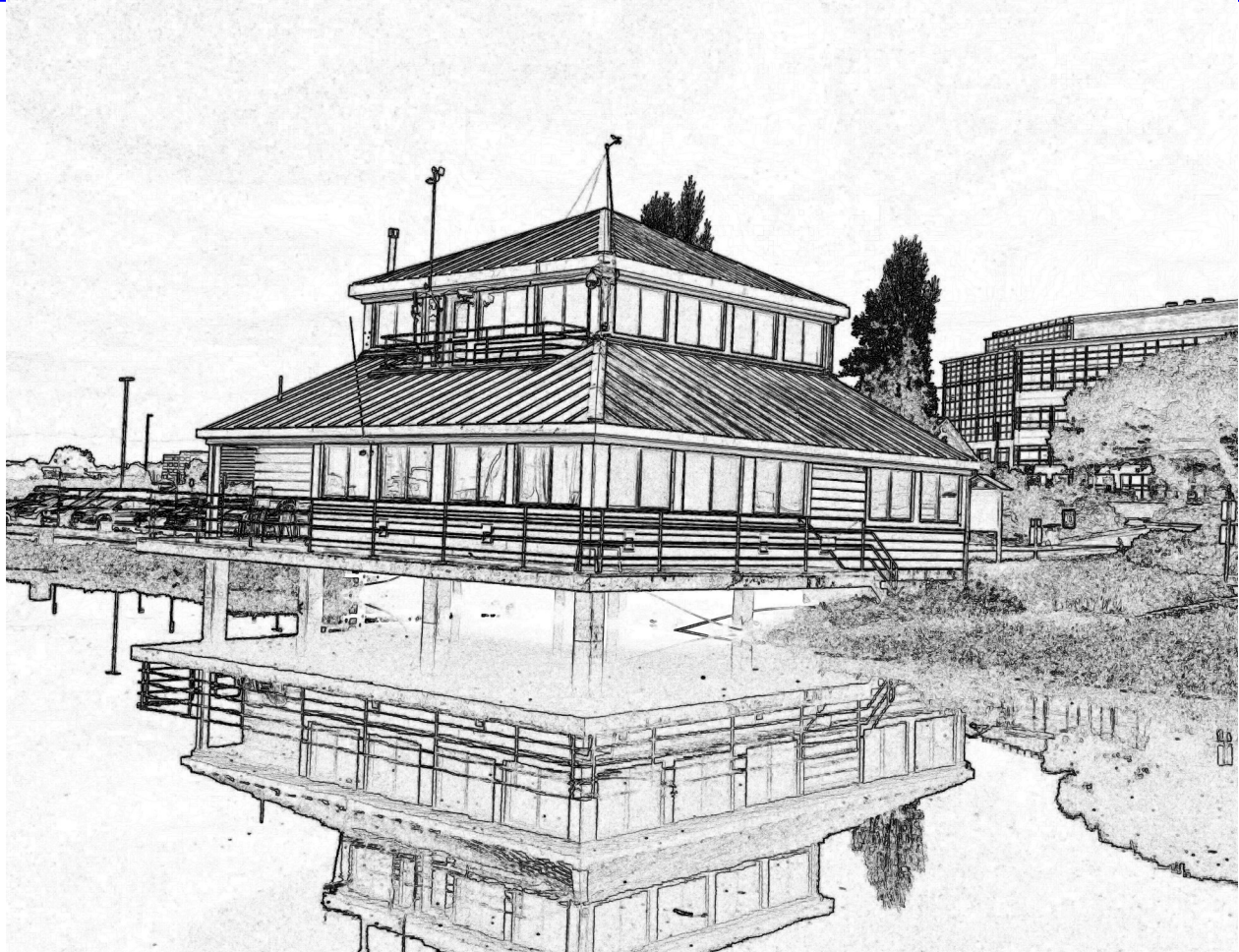
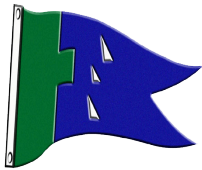
