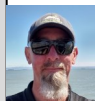

Brrrrr!

Albeit, we are still technically in a Winter month, however I think Mother Nature may be a little confused. Just because the groundhog may have seen it's shadow, doesn't necessarily mean we need to have 6 more weeks of extreme weather! Frankly, I'm over the sustained high winds, heavy downpours, and frigid temps. On multiple occasions, the wind gusts have challenged us walking down the docks and whether we could maintain a straight line; sadly, I don't think any of us have succeeded in doing so. Hold on!!

All jokes aside, with more wind and rain in the upcoming forecast, we all need to stay on top of the ever changing status of our boats. More specifically, ensure your dock lines are in good shape and not chafing any sharp objects, deck and cockpit scuppers are clear of debris, and your bilge pumps function properly in auto mode. Additionally, if you own a sailboat and have a headsail on a furler, please make sure the sail is in good shape, tightly wound on the headstay and the furler line is in good shape and secure. The long and short of it all, take a moment to come down and verify your vessel is ready for more weather.

Heading down the dock to some helpful reminders and other housekeeping items:

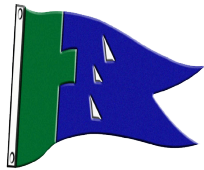
- * **Spring Ahead:** Sunday March 12 is the time to spring your clocks forward 1-hour for Daylight Savings.
- * **Safety Reminder:** The next time you stop in the office, or call in for any reason, please provide us updated contact information (phone and email). Keeping your account up to date is key in making sure we can contact whomever it may be necessary if the occasion arises.
- * **Maintenance Tip:** It is recommended to exercise your thru-hulls at least once a month. This will help prevent a thru-hull from potentially becoming frozen in the open or closed position. Additionally, taking the time each month to exercise the thru-hulls allows you to put eyes on them, and whether there is any corrosion or discoloration forming on the thru-hull.
- * **Reminder:** After hours scenario: If a broken hose spigot occurs, or a water line under the dock fails for any reason, please do not take the situation into your own hands by trying to turn off our water system to the dock. For your safety, please contact the Brisbane PD non-emergency line at: (415) 467-1212 to report the issue. They will contact the appropriate people to deal with the problem promptly and safely.
- * **Reminder:** Only basic household type trash belongs in our garbage cans. Please separate the recyclable items into their proper containers, located at the garbage enclosures by Dock 1 and Dock 4 in the parking lots. DO NOT put chemicals, engine parts, hoses, bulky items or other hazardous materials in our garbage receptacles. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated!

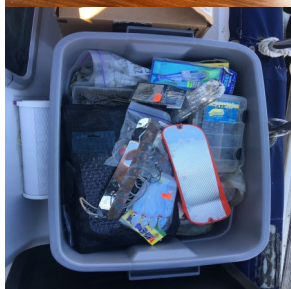
