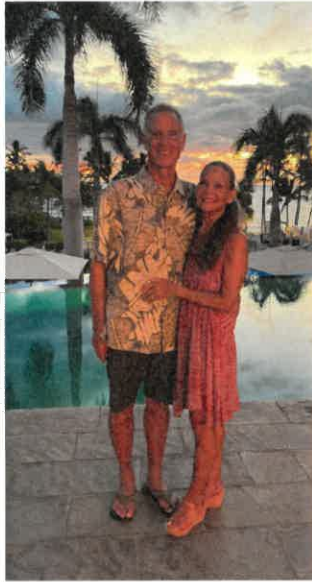

Along those lines, we will experience some minor fluctuations in the office as we navigate through the transition, and appreciate your patience and cooperation while we endure the search for someone to fill the front office position. Pushing off the seawall towards open waters:

- \* We are entering upon the windy season; please double check your dock lines and make sure they are in good condition, and sufficient size for enduring prolonged periods of wind.
- \* Roller furling sails are all the rage, especially when they come unfurled! Not only is it a danger to your boat when the sail starts flogging itself, but it can be a serious hazard to those around the boat too. Ensure your headsail is tightly furled, and the lines securing it are in good condition.
- \* Additionally, any loose items become a flying target as the winds pick up to gale + forces. In past wind events, we have seen bbq's loosen from their mounts, dinghies blown off the deck, and other cushions disappear into the next county. Take a moment to secure your belongings before they depart for places unknown.

In continuing the theme for safety, SILVER CHARM, a Coast Guard Auxiliary operational facility that resides here at Brisbane Marina, will be commemorating National Safe Boating Week on Sunday, May 22. Silver Charm will be visiting local marinas, affording the opportunity to see a USCG Aux Facility up close and personal, meet the crew, see some of the equipment she carries and find out about the kind of work she does. She will be tied up to our Guest Dock starting around 3pm till approx. 5pm. In addition to this opportunity, Sierra Point Yacht Club will also be hosting an Open House from noon to 5pm, providing information on what they do, and how you can potentially join their wonderful club.
