April Showers Bring May Flowers

Finally, some drier weather! Have you gotten out on the water yet?? I see lots of boats heading out, cruising out to popular destinations with other boaters, SPYC members, and fisherman on the hunt for the big catch.

If you're heading out for an anchorage, I received a few more places our boaters like to frequent in response to April's newsletter. If you're looking for a day anchorage and perhaps to catch a Giants game, McCovey Cove is a popular spot on the South side of the park near South Beach Marina. It also puts you a short dinghy ride to the shore to partake in some wonderful restaurants close by in the City. If you're looking for a little longer time at the hook, you may want to look into Aquatic Park on the North shoreline of San Francisco with a beautiful view of the Golden Gate Bridge. Or go a little bit further and find Paradise Cove on the Northeastern shore of the Tiburon peninsula. Another historical park near there is China Camp, also located in Marin County on the North side of the peninsula that becomes Pt. San Pedro.

With so many places to explore and try out, if you haven't already, should be a perfect excuse to provision the boat, grab a friend or partner, and head out for a nice get away. So what are you waiting for...

Meanwhile, back at the marina, here are some friendly tips and reminders:

South S.F. Scavenger, our trash and recycle company, has provided us with some composting bins for your home and/or your galley aboard. They are to hold all your food waste items in a small, yet convenient, vented bucket with a handle, to make trekking up to the green waste bin easy and hassle free. We have limited supplies, so if you would like one, please stop by our office to pick one up.



- * Recycling: South S.F. Scavenger also provided us with carry tote bags that help separate recyclable items into two compartments. One for flattened paper or cardboard, and the second for bottles, cans or other recyclable containers. These bags are limited stock on hand and can be picked up at the Marina Office as well.
- * Pets: Must be on a leash at all times in or around the marina. No pets may be allowed to wander the docks at any time.
- No chemicals or any other hazardous materials may be stored on the docks at any time. This includes, but is not limited to, camp fuel, gas, diesel, chemical cleaners, oil, grease, etc. Please help us keep our docks and waterways clean.
- Fire Extinguishers: have your checked yours lately? If not, you may want to, as fire extinguishers have a 12 year lifespan from the two digit date stamped in the bottom of the canister. If you need to dispose of an old, expired extinguisher, Recology on Tunnel Ave will take them. To replace the expired ones, please refer to USCG requirements for type, size and quantity needed for your boat size.


