So as the holidays set-in, remember to enjoy the time celebrated with family and friends. From our families to yours, *Happy Thanksgiving!*

Accompanying the Fall holidays, usually brings the cooler weather. I, for one, am enjoying the change in temperatures lately with brisk mornings, and longer evenings with it getting darker earlier. Perhaps a warm blanket and a good movie are in store. Additionally, a little bit of rain is in the forecast, but whether that weather comes to fruition, remains to be seen. Nonetheless, with the potential threat of fresh water washdowns in the near future, please make sure to close your ports & hatches, and make sure your scuppers or deck drains are clear.

Pouring over to a few helpful tips and friendly reminders:

- * **Tip:** For the sailors with roller furling: to help prevent unfurling of the headsail during a wind event, wrap your headsail 3-4 times (minimum) with your genoa lines and then cleat off the lines along with the furling line. Double check your lines are not frayed or in danger of chaffing on any sharp objects that could cause premature failure. A whipping headsail in a wind event can be very dangerous to you, your vessel and surrounding boaters.
- * **Cold Weather:** Can and typically will bring out a bad battery that may not have been suspect before. Take a moment to check your battery, water levels (if a wet cell) and charger; if needed, replace as necessary. A good battery and operational charger could mean the difference in keeping your bilge pump running if a water intake issue were to arise.
- * **Windows and Hatches:** Both of these are one of the most common issues for water leaks during wet weather. Review your gaskets around each hatch, and the sealant or gasket for your windows. Failure of either of these could leave you with a very damp feeling inside!
- * **Reminder:** There is **NO** renting or subletting of your vessel or slip. If there are any questions regarding this subject, please stop in or call the office to discuss.
- * **Parking:** Vehicles with expired registration are subject to citation and/or towing at the vehicle owner's expense. Marina parking permits do not absolve a vehicle or owner from State or Local vehicle regulations.



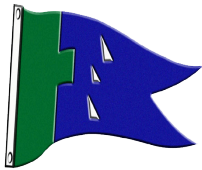
