Transferring to some important reminders:

- Animals: Dogs are to be leashed anytime they are off the boat and they cannot be left aboard the boat alone. Cats can be left aboard alone, however they cannot be left to roam the docks or property; they must stay aboard your boat.
- In walking the docks, I see a lot of dock lines that need some serious attention. Your dock lines are an essential piece of equipment to maintain proper attachment to the dock. Take a moment to check and replace yours if needed.
- Bilge pumps: They're not an exciting piece of equipment aboard any boat, but they sure are an important piece of making sure your boat has a chance of surviving if or when a water intake issue arises aboard. Check your bilge pump operation frequently. This would include also making sure the float switch, if applicable, is functioning properly and not obstructed by any wires, hoses or other debris in the bilge. It's sad that a boat can sink from such an easy and maintainable item. Please don't let your boat and investment hit bottom!
- Wind events: Fall and Winter are upon us soon, and that will typically bring wind at howling small craft warning proportions. Please ensure all your running rigging is pulled away from your mast to prevent clanging during a wind event, along with all items on deck are secure and won't blow off the boat and into the water.
- Items on the dock: For yours and others safety, do not store anything on the dock other than potentially a dock step. If items don't fit in the provided dock box or within your boat, it doesn't belong on the dock finger or head-walk.


