Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on **Tuesday, January 23, 2018**, at 7:30 p.m., Brisbane City Hall, 50 Park Place, Brisbane, to consider the following matter:

APPLICATION NO.: **Zoning Text Amendment RZ-1-18**

APPLICANT: **City of Brisbane**

LOCATION: **Citywide**

ZONING: **Citywide**

REQUEST: **Zoning Text Amendments to Chapter 17.33 of Title 17, Zoning, of the Brisbane Municipal Code to eliminate the prohibition of cannabis businesses within 600 feet of a school or daycare for properties located within the Crocker Industrial Park (TC-1 District) where such uses are conditionally permitted.**

ENVIRONMENTAL
STATUS: **The project is consistent with the General Plan per State CEQA Guidelines Section 15183(a)--this proposal falls within a class of projects which are consistent with existing zoning or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall therefore not require further review. The exception to this section requiring environmental review as might be necessary to examine project specific significant effects does not apply.**

If you challenge the application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
