Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on **Tuesday, June 26, 2018**, at 7:30 p.m., Brisbane City Hall, 50 Park Place, Brisbane, to consider the following matter:

**APPLICATION NO.:** Tentative Parcel Map TPM-1-18

**APPLICANT/OWNER:** Stephen R. Johnson, applicant/owner.

**LOCATION:** 661 San Bruno Avenue  
(Assessor's Parcel No. 007-362-090)

**ZONING:** R-3 Residential District

**REQUEST:** Tentative Parcel Map TPM-1-18 to establish a four-unit condominium development. The project received Design Permit, Variance, Fence Exception, and Use Permit approval at the June 12, 2018 Planning Commission meeting.

**ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS:** Categorical Exemption per State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301(I) and 15303(b)- this project falls within a class of projects which the State has determined not to have a significant effect on the environment. The exceptions to this categorical exemption referenced in Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines do not apply.

If you challenge the application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
