NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on Thursday, January 14, 2016, at 7:30 p.m., Brisbane City Hall, 50 Park Place, Brisbane, to consider the following matter:

APPLICATION NO.: Use Permit UP-2-15 and Design Permit DP-1-15

APPLICANT/OWNER: Joseph J. Railla, applicant; Lon Carter, owner

LOCATION: 23 San Bruno Avenue

(Assessor's Parcel No. 007-223-080)

ZONING: NCRO-2 Neighborhood Commercial District

REQUEST: Use Permit and Design Permit to allow for the

construction of an approximately 31-foot high, threestory, mixed-use building, including four 1,250 sq. ft. to 1,323 sq. ft. residential units on the second and third floors and an approximately 550 sq. ft. ground floor commercial space and ground floor parking, to replace the existing single-story commercial building

on a 5,000 sq. ft. lot.

If you challenge the application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
