B. Discuss Implementation Guidelines

Schillinger gave an overview of the guidelines and possible options. Schillinger said that most cities have their Art Committee projects go directly to Council for approval. He also discussed the background for the creation of the Selection Art Committee, which was based on an incident that occurred in a SF neighborhood where the residents didn't feel the art installed represented their area.

The Committee discussed removing the Park & Recreation Commission once approved by the Committee as there are already two Commissioners on the Committee represented. There is also an appointed community artist on the Committee. After much discussion, the Committee agreed.

Grossman and Salmon have concerns about removing the Selection Committee.

Cunningham suggested to allow for flexibility on having a Selection Committee when one is warranted. The Committee agreed to that change in the guidelines.

Schillinger will bring the suggested changes to the Public Arts Guidelines at either the 6/17 or 7/15 City Council Meeting.

The Committee also discussed further about hiring a consultant to assist in facilitating the Public Art Committee with choosing artists, RFPs, and other matters.

Future meeting topics the Committee would like to discuss soon is exploring the idea of selecting a consultant, and possible art piece(s) at the old library or along Visitacion.
