APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. Approve Minutes from October 27th, 2021 Public Art Advisory Committee

PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

B. Discussion of Land Art Presentations Moderated by the Nevada Museum of Art Reno

The Committee discussed the presentations and enjoyed some of the discussions about forms of earth art and evolution of land art, but some felt that it was too advanced and hard to envision where it could be done. Grossman sent some links that are more introductory lessons about art. Schillinger would like the group to focus on the values they would like to bring through their art, such as environmentalism and multiculturalism, and think about the impact and discussion that the art could invoke with the community.

C. Review the City's Properties and Possible Art Locations

The Committee reviewed the map designating which properties the City owns. They discussed various areas where they would like to focus on an art project and whether they should focus on a temporary piece or a permanent one. The Committee decided to focus on 1) Visitation, 2) Walkways, 3) park behind restrooms, 4) entrance to town, 5) Parcel 5 (in Sierra Point Parkway). They want to be sure that art projects engage the community.
