
Typical Installation



DOUBLE CHECK VALVE ASSEMBLY (DCVA)

Notes:

- 1. DCVA must be listed on the San Mateo County Environmental Health Services list of Approved Devices, or be approved by the City Engineer.
- 2. Installation must meet the requirements in AWWA Standard C510-17.
- 3. Assembly must be installed with a minimum of 12" between the lowest portion of the assembly and grade, floor or platform.
- 4. The Assembly must have a minimum side clearance of 12", except that a minimum side clearance of 24" must be provided on the side of the assembly that contains the test cocks.
- 5. All backflow protection must be located at the water user's service connection unless an alternate location is approved by the City Engineer.
- 6. Pipe unions required on both ends of double check valve.
- 7. A Reduced Pressure Assembly may be required for high hazard conditions, as determined by the City Engineer.
